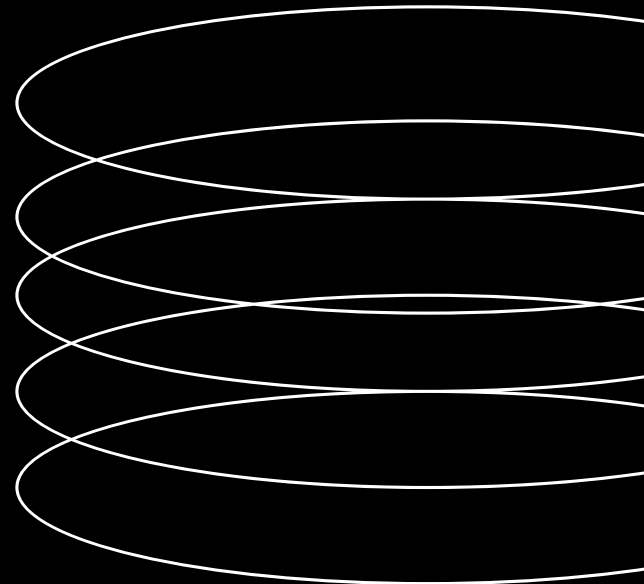


Prayer 21 Guide

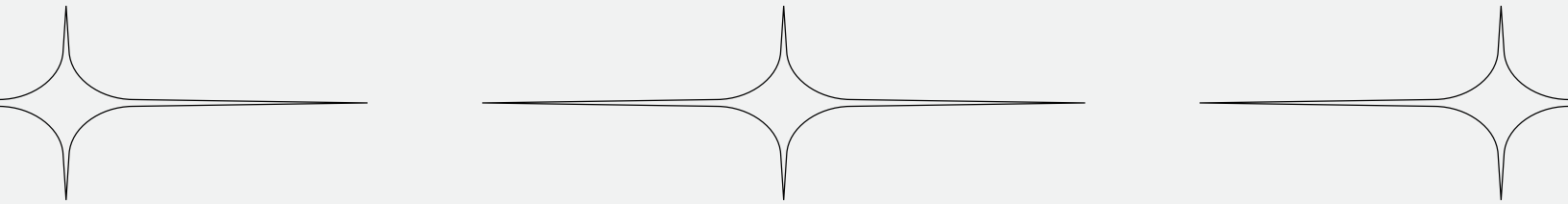

Day 1: SURRENDER

Scripture: He must become greater and greater, and I must become less and less.
John 3:30 NLT

Personal Prayer: God help me to prioritize prayer in my life from a place of surrender. I surrender my thoughts, my plans, my ways as I invite Your will to do be done in my life. I make room for you as I want more of You and less of me. In Jesus' Name, Amen.



Day 2: PEACE

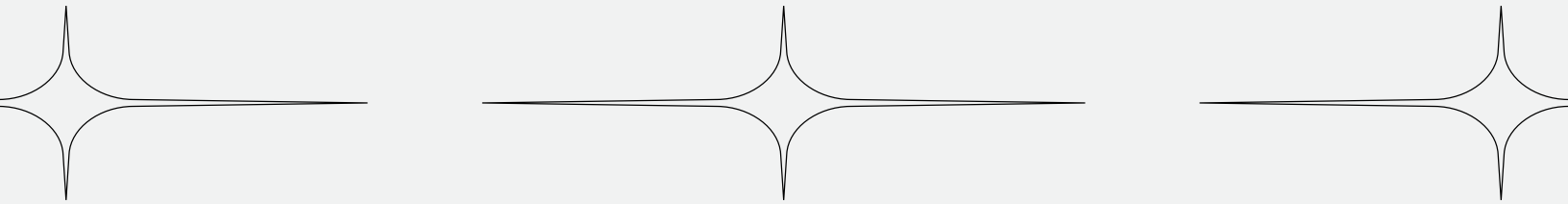

Help me to see them as You do. Restore now. Heal now. I believe the best is yet to come as I entrust my family to You. In Jesus' Name, Amen.



Day 4: WORRY

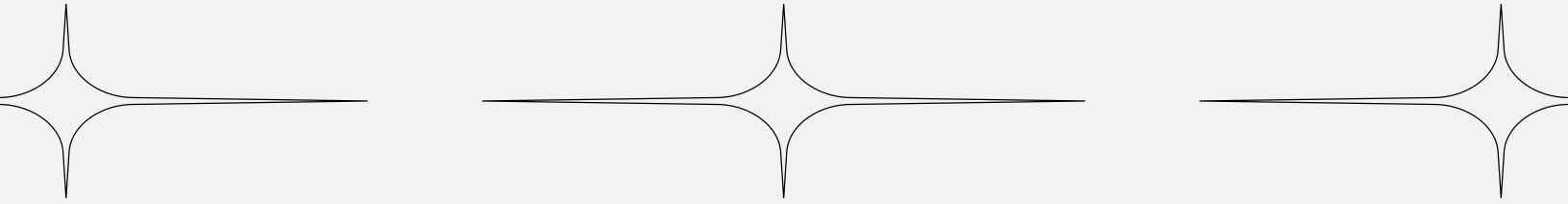
Scripture: Don't fret or worry. Instead of worrying, pray. Let petitions and praises shape your worries into prayers, letting God know your concerns. Before you know it, a sense of God's wholeness, everything coming together for good, will come and settle you down. It's wonderful what happens when Christ displaces worry at the center of your life. **Philippians 4:6-7 MSG**

Personal Prayer: Lord, I surrender every care, every burden, and all of my worries to You. Whatever is bothering me I submit it to You in prayer. I lay down physical and mental anxiety (tell Him all the things you want to lay down). I place my concerns before You and make You the center of my thoughts. In the mighty name of Jesus. Amen.

Day 5: ALL WILL KNOW JESUS

Scripture: For the Son of Man [a] came to seek and save those who are lost.
Luke 19:10 NLT

Personal Prayer: Father, I know Your heart is for no one to be lost without You. Today I bring _____ before You (pray specifically for those who need to know Christ). Use me to be an example and extension of Your love in their lives. God open their ears to hear Your voice. I thank You for being a saving God, a life-changing God, a forgiving God, and a transforming God. We claim it done in Jesus' Name, Amen.

1 Corinthians 10:13 NIV

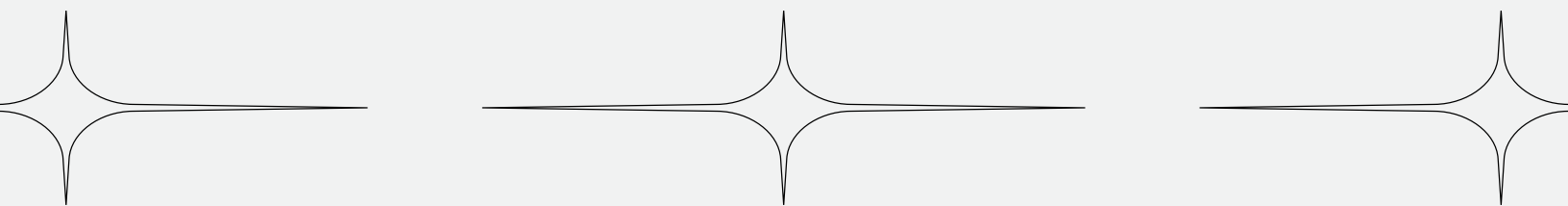
So if the Son sets you free, you will be free indeed. **John 8:36 NIV**

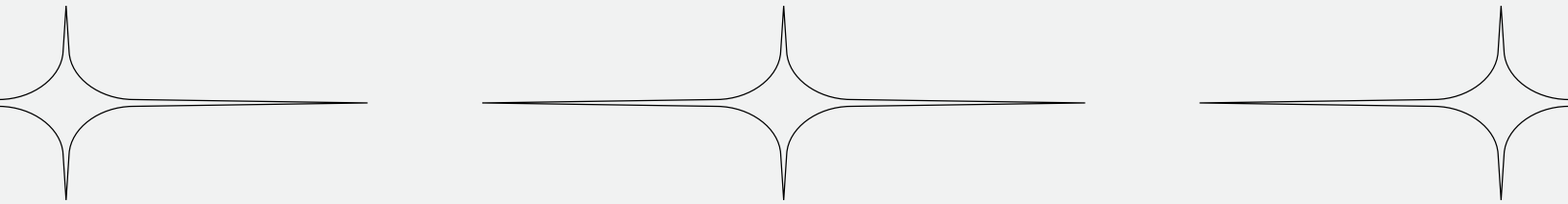

Day 9: WISDOM FOR LEADERS

Scripture: If any of you lacks wisdom, let him ask God, who gives generously to all without reproach, and it will be given him. **James 1:5 ESV**

Personal Prayer: God, today I pray for my pastors, bosses, and all in leadership. I ask you to help us to lead. To lead we need your wisdom. Day 10: POWER OVER THE ENEMY

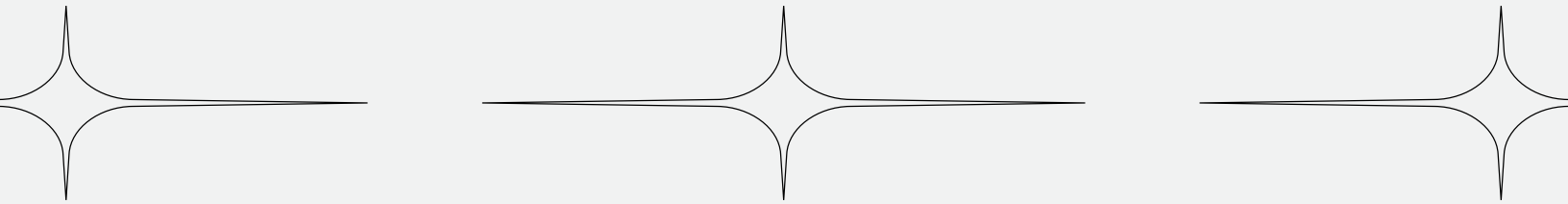

Day 12: PURPOSE

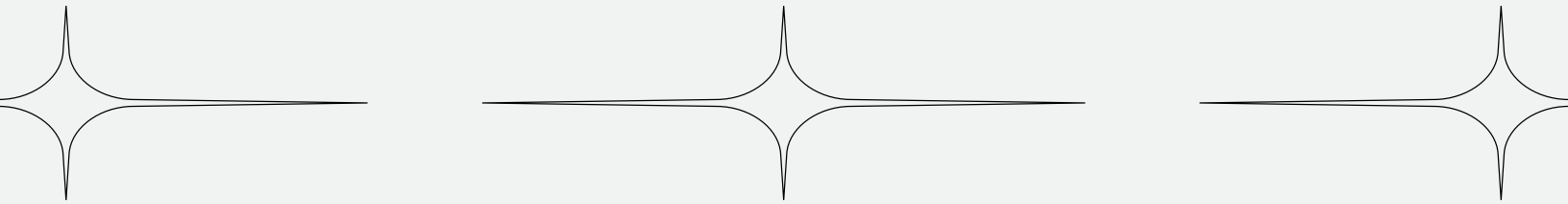

Personal Prayer: Father, today I pray for all in government and in authority. I pray that You would lead, guide, and give them wisdom. I pray that You would do a supernatural work in our nation as we are desperate for You. In the name of Jesus, Amen.



Day 14: OUR CITY

Scripture: When right-living people bless the city, it flourishes. **Proverbs 11:11 A MSG**

Personal Prayer: Lord, I lift my city before You. You have planted me in this region for a purpose. I speak now that as I bless my city, it will flourish. In Jesus' Name, Amen.

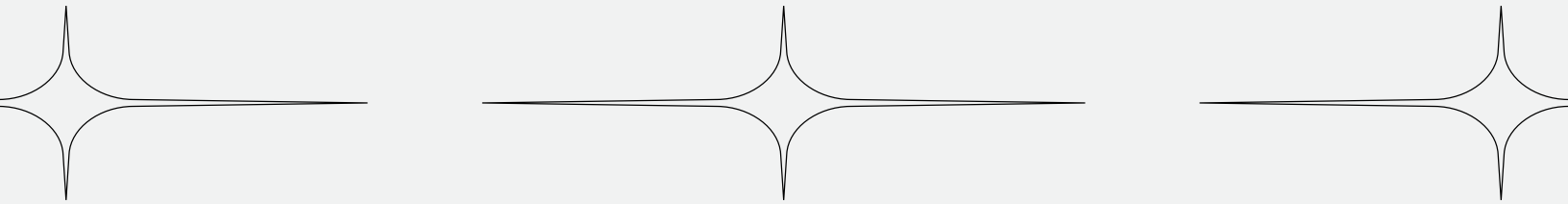

Day 15: PROTECTION

Scripture: For he will rescue you from every trap and protect you from deadly disease.
4 He will cover you with his feathers. He will shelter you with his wings. His faithful promises are your armor and protection. **Psalms 91:3-4 NLT**

Day 16: LOVING ONE ANOTHER

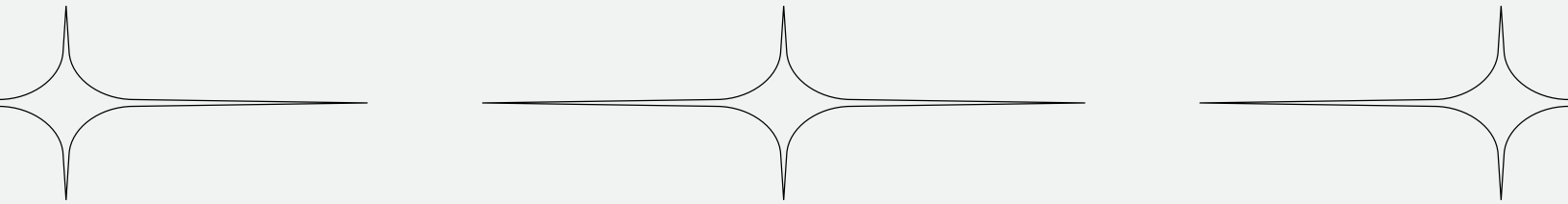

Scripture: Let no corrupting talk come out of your mouths, but only such as is good for building up, as fits the occasion, that it may give grace to those who hear.

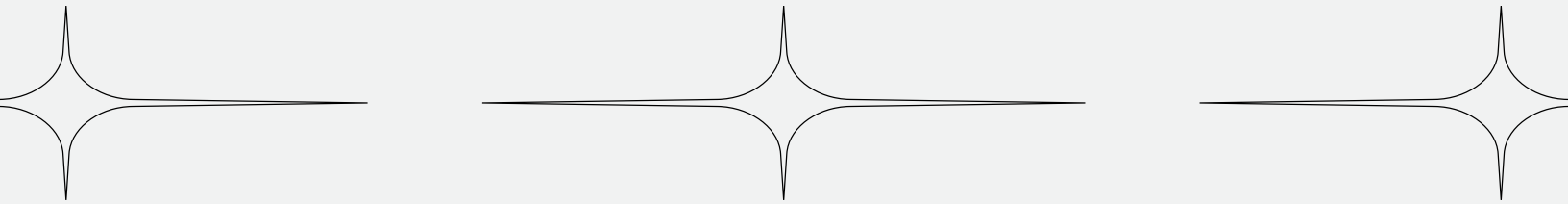
Ephesians 4:29 ESV

Day 20: BOLDNESS

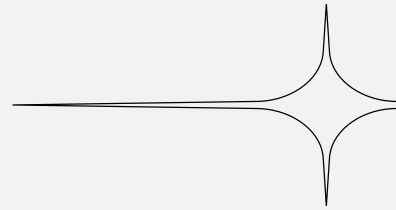
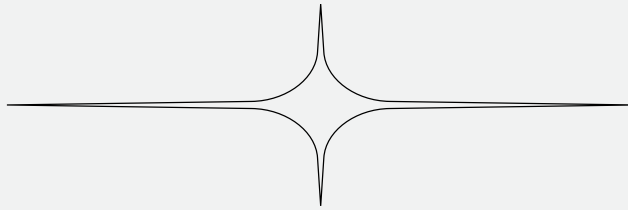
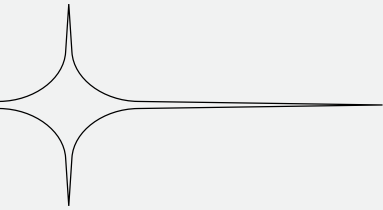
Scripture: Therefore, since we have such a hope, we are very bold.
